
Last May we collected **117 donations which is our current high record.**

Whether it was making his younger brother and sister jump off the highest cliff into the water 60 ft below, or inviting someone to come join the party, Zach was sure to share his motto of Carpe Diem with all. At 27 years old, Zach accomplished more than many, including obtaining an undergraduate degree from Middlebury College, working and traveling in China for 5 years, and starting a promising future studying International Trade and Development at University of Pennsylvania's prestigious Wharton/Lauder Program. This well-rounded young man had a passion for life that was simply contagious.

Tragedy does not discriminate and can strike at any time. The Woods family knows this all too well. On May 6, 2014, Zach was a victim of a devastating traffic accident, while walking to class. After approximately 12 hours, multiple operations and several blood transfusions, the damage and bleeding caused by the accident were too extensive and doctors were unable to save the life of this remarkable young man.
