## Free Rabies Clinic

The Orange County Department of Health, in cooperation with the Town of Woodbury will be holding a free animal rabies vaccination clinic in the Town of Woodbury on June 11, 2017.

The clinics are open to cats, dogs and ferrets of Orange County residents only. All pets must be restrained by leash or carrier and proof of prior vaccination should be brought to the clinic for the 3-year shot. Ferret shots are only good for <u>one year</u> regardless of prior proof of vaccinations.
