Residential Refuse Pickup

Village Residents Pickup: Monday & Thursday

Town Residents Pickup: Tuesday & Friday

Limit of (2) Cans Per Pickup

Any garbage exceeding the guidelines will not be picked up & any garbage not placed in receptacles will not be picked up.

Bulk Item Pickup

Village Residents Bulk Pickup: Thursday

Town Residents Bulk Pickup: Friday

Limit of (1) Item Per Week

Bulk Pickup begins the 1st Thursday in April & ends the last Friday in December.

Acceptable Items for Pickup:

Furniture, *appliances, rugs, toilet bowls, mattresses, gas grills (no tank), hot water heaters, *refrigerators, *freezers, *AC units.

*Doors must be removed from all appliances (refrigerators, freezers, ovens, stoves, dishwashers, washers, and dryers). *

*Refrigerants (Freon) must be removed from refrigerators, freezers, and AC units by a licensed professional and properly tagged. *

Unacceptable Items for Pickup:

Construction Debris, Tires, Grass, Brush & Leaves, Computers, Televisions, Batteries & Lawn Mowers.

***PLEASE CONTINUE TO PLACE ALL RECEPTACLES CURBSIDE THE NIGHT BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED PICKUP. ***

Residential Recycling Pickup

Village & Town Residents Recycling Pickup: Wednesday

Paper & co-mingled can be placed in either the green recycle container provided by the town or a garbage can clearly labeled for recycling.

*Recycling placed in plastic bags **will not be picked up.**

Plastic bags are prohibited.*

Recyclable Items Include:

Tin & Aluminum Cans & Foil

Plastic Containers & Cartons – **remove caps & rinse.**

Glass, bottles & jars – **remove caps & rinse.**

Mixed Papers – **newspapers, magazines, cardboard, paper, boxes.**

Brown craft cardboard must be flattened and tied.

Recycling Totes are available for pickup at the Town of Monroe Highway Department located at 87 Mine Road.

Compost Facilities

The town's compost facilities located on Lakes Road & Mine Road operate seasonally and hours will be communicated accordingly.
