NOTICE REGARDING COVID-19 VIRUS (CORONAVIRUS)

The Centers for Disease Control have advised people to take precautions in light of the COVID-19 virus (coronavirus) situation and have noted that the best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus. In an effort to protect all, the Town of Monroe Court asks that you follow these guidelines:

YOU SHOULD NOT ENTER THE COURTHOUSE IF YOU:

- Have flu-like symptoms; or
- Have been in any of the following countries within the last 14 days: China, South Korea, Japan, Italy, Iran; or
- Reside or have had close contact with anyone who has been in one of the countries listed above within the last 14 days; or
- Have been directed to quarantine, isolate or self-monitor at home for the coronavirus by any doctor, hospital or health agency; or
- Have been diagnosed with, or have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19.

If you fit into any of the above categories, **YOU SHOULD NOT ENTER THE COURTHOUSE.**

If you have a scheduled Court appearance, or you are otherwise required to appear at the Court and you are unable because of the guidelines listed above, you will not be penalized for your absence provided:

- if you are represented by an attorney, your attorney promptly contacts the Court.
- if you are an attorney, or you are not represented by an attorney, you promptly call the Court at 845-783-1900 ext. 3.
