

**LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2021
OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF MONROE, NEW YORK
AMENDING CHAPTER 33A OF THE
TOWN CODE OF THE TOWN OF MONROE**

A LOCAL LAW to amend Chapter 33A of the Town Code of the Town of Monroe entitled “Noise” pursuant to New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.

BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authority

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Section 10 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 2. Title and Purpose

This Local Law shall be known as and may be cited as “Local Law No. 2 of 2021.”

The purpose of this local law is to amend Chapter 33A of the Town of Monroe Code, specifically section 33A-7 to permit the Town of Monroe Code Enforcement Officer, his or designee, and law enforcement officers to enforce the provisions of Chapter 33A and to pursue the prosecution thereof in a court of competent jurisdiction.

Section 3. Amendment

Chapter 33A, Section 33A-7 “Enforcement” is hereby amended and shall state as follows:

§ 33A-7 Enforcement.

The provisions of this Chapter shall be enforced by the Code Enforcement Officer, or his or her designee, or other law enforcement officers that have the power, pursuant to the NYS Criminal Procedure Law, to arrest persons or issue appearance tickets in the Town of Monroe for the commission of violations.

Section 4. Repeal, Amendment, and Supersession of Other Laws.

All other Resolutions, Ordinances or Local Laws of the Town of Monroe, which conflict with the provisions of this Local Law are hereby superseded or repealed to the extent necessary to give this Local Law full force and effect.

Section 5. State Environmental Quality Review Act

Pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5 (33), this Local Law is classified as a Type II action which requires no further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Section 6. Severability

If any provisions of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Local Law shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order or judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any article, section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision or clause of this Local Law.

Section 7. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
